Introduction

In his *Drawing Acts*, our late, lamented colleague David Rosand wrote evocatively about the art of drawings and the act of looking at them, calling our attention to "the profound implications of tracing a line, of recording the motions of a hand..." In the opening paragraphs of that book's preface, however, David also noted some of the contingencies prevailing upon the study of graphic arts: "drawings, for good reasons of preservation, are kept locked in cabinets, guarded by their curators or keepers" and accordingly, "instead of being subject to continuing critical scrutiny they are briefly exhibited, attributed, catalogued – 'published,' as we say – and then reconsigned to the darkness of their solander boxes."

Those first paragraphs of David's memorable book might also be used to summon up the wonder of *Master Drawings New York*. The study of drawings is a rare pleasure, and at no other moment during the year is it possible to see so many – and such various – drawings on view. Freed from the darkness of their solander boxes, drawings are exhibited during this week not only at the Morgan Library or the Metropolitan Museum of Art, but at twenty or more galleries between those two august institutions bracketing the East Side of New York. At no other time of the year can one contemplate the possibilities and implications of so many lines.

Many of the drawings exhibited during *Master Drawings New York* will be new discoveries, works not previously seen or published. In some cases, there are new attributions to be debated. In many cases, the significance of a new drawing is still to be fully understood. During one cold week in January we can all – curators, scholars, dealers, collectors, and budding

amateurs – share together in this process of debate and discovery in the galleries. We may race around from opening to opening, trying to see our colleagues from out of town, or to be the first to reserve the most desirable drawings on offer; over the course of the week, however, we will circle back to discuss these works, to have a quiet, contemplative second look after the crush of opening nights. Only a small number of these sheets will go immediately into public collections where they can be consulted again with relative ease. The chance to see things before they once again disappear is not to be missed.

Too often, we visit museums to study a group of drawings with a specific project in mind, or we visit an exhibition in which drawings have been selected to demonstrate the development of an artist or the illustration of a particular theme. The body of drawings that come to the market in a given year, however, forces us to visit *Master Drawings New York* with a less calculated frame of mind. The very randomness of what we see during the week leads us, perhaps, to a more elemental appreciation of the works on view: we can examine drawings not so much in relation to one another, but simply with an open eye. We can return to another of the approaches recommended by David Rosand in *Drawing Acts*: to a connoisseurship not of particular artists, but rather, of the very act of drawing – a connoisseurship of line itself.
