Christopher Bishop Fine Art is based on New York's Upper East Side and specializes in Master Drawings and Paintings dating from the sixteenth through the twentieth centuries.

Mr. Bishop has worked independently as a private dealer in the field of Old Master drawings for more than a decade. He has restored to the canon of art history such remarkable works as Pierre Monier's Medea Slaying her Children (1665–66, sold to the Yale University Art Gallery in 2005), Gerrit van Honthorst's Idolatry of Solomon (ca. 1625, now in the collections of the Musée du Louvre), Federico Barrocci's Study for the Head of Saint Dominic (ca. 1589–93, now a promised gift by a private New York collector to the Frick Collection), and Alessandro Algardi's Design for a Reliquary with Two Supporting Angels for Pope Innocent X (sold in 2018 to an esteemed New York collection).

Christopher mounts exhibitions of Master Drawings in New York several times a year and is committed to a rigorous program of scholarly publications. Recent undertakings have included a major monograph on the sixteenth-century Mannerist artist Jacopo Pontormo and his drawings for the Villa Castello outside of Florence (2018), and a project devoted to the seventeenth-century Bolognese master Guercino, which reunited the painting of Aurora discovered by Christopher in 2012 with artist's preparatory drawing for the work (2019), garnering substantial press attention.



Colnaghi Elliott Master Drawings - a collaboration between Colnaghi and Elliott Fine Art - combines Colnaghi's venerable tradition of handling the most art historically significant works on paper and Elliott Fine Art's interest in bringing to the fore important works by lesser-known figures.

Founded in 1760, Colnaghi's reputation in Old Master drawings has been long established, selling works by Leonardo, Guercino, Giambattista Tiepolo and, among others, French masters such as Watteau and Fragonard. Celebrated during the 20th century as a gallery straddling the worlds of scholarship, connoisseurship and commerce, this great tradition both continues and is reinvigorated through this new partnership.





Mireille Mosler Ltd. is pleased to participate for the thirteenth year in Master Drawings exhibiting an eclectic mix of European paintings and drawings from the sixteenth century through the beginning of the twentieth century. The earliest works are four drawings by Adriaan de Weerdt (c. 1510 - c. 1590), an intriguing Flemish Renaissance artist by whom only a small number of works on paper survive. The four grisailles were executed in the early 1570s in Cologne, a sanctuary for artists fleeing the Low Countries. A *noir* by the French symbolist Odilon Redon's (1840-1916) explores the color black, achieving a variety of shades and textures with the use of charcoal. Other drawings by the British-Greek Marie Spartali Stillman (1844-1927), member of the second generation of the Pre-Raphaelite Brotherhood, and by the Dutch-Indonesian artist Jan Toorop (1858-1928) convey artistic developments in the twentieth century.



Promenades on Paper: Eighteenth-Century French Drawings from the Bibliothèque Nationale de France

In partnership with the Bibliothèque nationale de France (BnF), the Clark is organizing the first exhibition of the library's eighteenth-century French drawings. The selection of eighty-six enchanting studies, architectural plans, albums, sketchbooks, prints, and optical devices expands our understanding of drawing as a tool of documentation and creation in the age of Enlightenment, spanning the domains of natural history, current events, theater design, landscape, and portraiture. Displayed together, these objects immerse audiences in the world of eighteenth-century France—a world shaped by invention, erudition, and spectacle. Works by celebrated artists of the period such as François Boucher (1703–1770) and Gabriel de Saint-Aubin (1724–1780) are featured alongside exquisite drawings by lesser-known practitioners, including talented women, royal children, and visionary architects.

The exhibition is on at the Clark in Williamstown, Massachusetts until March 12, 2023. It will be on view at the Musée des Beauxarts de Tours (France) May 12 – August 28, 2023.
